



Study Habits

Family will ...

- Establish a consistent study place that is quiet, well-lit and free of distractions (ex. TV, phones, electronic devices, etc.)
- Ensure that their child completes homework in addition to nightly independent reading
- Monitor study time and offer praise and encouragement
- Check folder/assignment notebook daily to ensure homework is complete
- Communicate all pertinent information regarding their child.

Students will...

- Study at home in a consistent place that is quiet, well-lit and free of distractions (ex. TV, phones, electronic devices, etc.)
- Seek and accept help with homework, but take ownership of it
- Complete all assignments on time
- Commit to completing homework in addition to nightly independent reading

Staff will ...

- Explicitly teach and model good study behaviors
- Teachers will provide homework (in addition to independent reading) to reinforce problem solving skills as appropriate

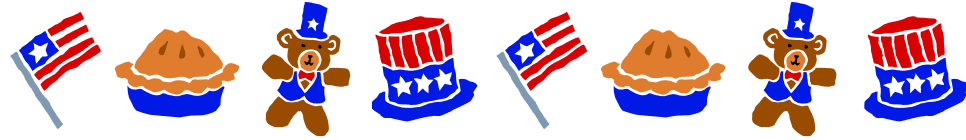

School and Home Expectations

Fundamental Purpose at Liberty

- Ensure that all students become lifelong learners and contributing members to the community.

Literacy

Family will ...

- Know what their child is reading and writing
- Discuss their child's reading and writing
- Encourage their child to read and write daily

Students will...

- Explore different genres (Science Fiction, Realistic Fiction, etc.) and purposes for writing (narrative, expository, persuasive)
- Read and write every day for learning and enjoyment
- Talk with family, friends, and teachers about their reading and writing

Staff will ...

- Provide materials and time for daily reading and writing at school
- Provide small group instruction in reading and writing
- Foster the love of reading and writing
- Provide opportunities to discuss complex texts and write for a variety of purposes

Math

Family will ...

- Know what their child is learning in math
- Discuss math concepts
- Apply math skills in your child's daily life
- Review math homework with your child

Students will...

- Practice math facts every day
- Talk about ways that you use math outside of school with family and friends
- Complete your math homework

Staff will ...

- Provide materials and opportunities for students to practice math skills
- Provide instructional support that meets the needs of a variety of ability levels
- Foster the love of math
- Provide classroom time for independent math and problem solving skills



Respect & Responsibility

Family will ...

- Ensure child attends school consistently and arrives on time
- Engage their child in conversations about school
- Teach and model responsible decision making, including positive and negative consequences
- Attend educational meetings to support child's academic needs

Students will...

- Respect personal and classroom property
- Arrive to and leave school with all necessary materials
- Enter classroom promptly at first bell, ready to learn
- Pay attention
- Ask questions when help is needed
- Demonstrate safe, caring, respectful and responsible behavior

Staff will ...

- Teach and model responsible decision making, including positive and negative consequences
- Articulate and hold students accountable for meeting expectations
- Teach, model, and encourage good character traits (Respect, Responsibility, Trustworthiness, Citizenship, Fairness, Compassion, Honesty, Integrity, Perseverance, and Self-Discipline)
- Encourage students to take ownership of their learning
- Communicate pertinent information to parents
